Residence Permit:

Citizens of the Nordic countries do not need residence permit.
Citizens of the EEA and Switzerland intending to stay for less than six months do not need a residence permit, but they shall register their residence with the National Registry, Þjóðskrá. Students planning to stay longer than six months will have to apply for an extension of residence during their stay in the country.
